

THE BROOKLANDS MEMORIAL TROPHY CONTEST

GOODWOOD today is the successor to the pre-war Brooklands in more than one way. In that Memorial Garden at the side of the Paddock there is part of the old Weybridge banking, bearing (so the legend says—and the marks tend to give credence to the story) the imprint of the tyres of the Napier of S. F. Edge which set up a 24-hour endurance record even before the concrete of the Surrey track was dry.

Here, too, is the traditional home of the B.A.R.C., now British Automobile Racing Club but also legal successor to the Brooklands Automobile Racing Club which ran its life concurrently and was—when Brooklands had been lost forever as a motor racing venue—taken over by the then Junior Car Club.

More than anything else, Goodwood is the home of the spirit of Brooklands, where clubmen race for the love of it, perhaps to cut a dash in front of their girl friends or because it is the way to get on in the world of speed. They do it at the Members' Meetings because they want to and not because there is any material gain.

The *Motor Sport* Brooklands Memorial Challenge Trophy plays a part in this happy atmosphere. No one is going to spend a small fortune to win it, for the cash prizes will never pay for a Cosworth engine, and a Grand Prix team will do no more than show passing interest in the driver who has nothing more than the Brooklands Memorial Trophy to recommend him. But such past winners as Mike Hawthorn and Innes Ireland are sure pointers to the value of the typical Club racing training which is available here for those who can benefit from participating, and so it is with interest that we watch people like Rodney Bloor, Eddie Fletcher and Bobby Buchanan-Michaelson, who have a second go today at winning points, having already put up good performances at the March meeting. Red: Signal for complete and immediate stop. **Yellow (Waved):** Great danger, be prepared to stop. **Yellow (Motionless):** Take care, danger. **Yellow with Vertical Red Stripes:** Take care, oil has been spilled somewhere on the road. **Blue (Waved):** Another competitor is trying to overtake you. **Blue (Motionless):** Another competitor is following you very closely. **White:** An ambulance or service car is on the circuit. **Black (with Competitor's Number):** Signal for the competitor to stop on the next lap. **Black and White Chequered:** Signal for the winner and end of the race. BROOKLANDS MEMORIAL TROPHY

TODAY'S meeting is the second of four Members' Meetings at Goodwood in 1963 at which points will be awarded for the *Motor Sport* Brooklands Memorial Challenge Trophy. The driver who collects most points during the season wins the trophy, a replica and £75. Second and third places win £50 and £25 respectively.

Points are awarded on an inverse position basis up to fourth place in each class, but should there be seven or fewer starters in a class the points for each place are halved.

Leading points winners so far are: 8 points, R. J. Bloor; 7 pts., A. Deacon; 6 pts., D. E. Fletcher; 5 pts., A. C. Dence; 4 pts., R. Embley, E. Hardwicke, B. D. Hetreed, M. B. Johnson and R. Buchanan-Michaelson.

CHRIS BRISTOW MEMORIAL TROPHY

THIS challenge trophy, presented by W. H. Bristow in memory of his son Christopher, is awarded annually to the competitor recording the fastest lap at a Goodwood Meeting restricted to B.A.R.C. members. The 1962 winner was John Fenning.

DUNCAN HAMILTON TROPHY

THIS meeting counts towards the Duncan Hamilton Challenge Trophy which is awarded annually to a member of the Jaguar Drivers Club driving a Jaguar or a Jaguar-engined car.

Scoring will be based on a cumulative points system and restricted to Goodwood meetings.

FREDDY DIXON and PETER COLLINS TROPHIES

BOTH the "Freddie Dixon" Trophy and the Peter Collins Memorial Challenge Trophy are awards which the B.A.R.C.

are proud to present. Donated by the Middlesbrough and District Motor Club, the attractive silver Fred. W. Dixon Trophy is awarded to the season's most successful driver in "Marque" sports car races for which the eligible cars are: A.C. Ace and Aceca, Austin Healey (not Sprite model), Daimler SP250, Lotus Elite (F.W.E. with single S.U. carb.), M.G. A. and M.G. B., Morgan +4, Sunbeam Alpine 1½ and 1.6 litre, T.V.R. Grantura (M.G. A. engine), Triumph TR2, TR3 and TR4 and Elva Courier. Points are gained on an inverse position basis to fourth place. Past winners include: David Shale (Austin Healey) 1958; Chris Lawrence (Morgan) 1959; Colin Hextall (Triumph) 1960; Bob Staples (A.C.) 1961; David Eva (M.G.) 1962.

Donated by his friends at Alcester Preparatory School the Peter Collins Trophy keeps alive the memory of a top-line driver and sportsman. The best novice driver of the year at B.A.R.C. Members' Meetings at Goodwood is decided upon at the end of the season by a B.A.R.C. committee. Past winners of the trophy are: W. McCowen, 1960; R. H. McArthur, 1962.
