





PADDOCK GOSSIP

A brief round-up of some of the latest motor racing news.

Today's meeting is organised by a local club—the Maidstone & Mid-Kent Motor Club—who are indeed no strangers to Brands Hatch. They must be unique in that they have a lady chairman who also organises their race meetings—Jane Waugh. Mrs. Waugh has put a lot of work into the organisation of today's racing and no doubt the result will be an efficiently-run pleasant meeting.

The outright lap record for the 1.24-mile Brands Hatch Club Circuit is in jeopardy today. Entered in the Guards Trophy sports-racing car race is the 5970 c.c. Lola-Chevrolet T70 sports-racing car of young Wrexham farmer Robin Darlington to be driven by the 30-year-old Bradford-born Radio London driver Tony Lanfranchi.

Tony is a great favourite at Brands, where he has been seen in all types of cars from Lotus 7s and Hillman Imps to big sports cars. The 6-litre Lola has far too much power to be raced flat-out on the tricky, twisting Brands Hatch circuit, so Lanfranchi will have to tame the 500 horsepower pretty carefully to keep the car on the road. However, Tony should be well able to cope with the power, for he drove a similar Lola at Brands Hatch last year and came within an ace of conquering the circuit record of 52 secs.

Event 2 for Special Grand Touring cars is a qualifying round of the 1967 Motoring News Championship. Outright favourite must be northerner Tony Dean with his very potent 2-litre Porsche Carrera 6. Just listen to this car as it races past—it makes a glorious noise! Ranged against him are the nimble Ginetta G12s of Peter Creasey, Keith Jupp and Paul Bryan, the Lotus 47s of John Miles and Johnnie Blades and Digby Martland and John Lepp with Chevron GTs. Chris Meek is also entered with a Nathan GT, so it should be a splendid race!

With Alan Rollinson and Chris Williams racing abroad today, Harry Stiller stands a good chance of taking the lead in the Les Leston Formula 3 Championship, which he won last year. In today's race he drives his 1967 Brabham-Ford BT21 entered jointly by Motor Racing Stables and Radio London, and his team-mate is none other than Tony Lanfranchi.

Look out for John Miles today. This young driver is this year driving for

Lotus Components, Ltd., in both Formula 3 racing with a Lotus 41 and in special GT racing with a Lotus 47. He is down to drive both cars today. John is the son of actor Bernard Miles and writes a column about club racing in the monthly magazine Cars & Car Conversions.

If you haven't already, mark down July 30 in your diary as the day to come to Brands Hatch. The BOAC 500-miles race has already attracted the firm entry of one of the automatic-transmission, air-brake "winged" Chaparral 2F sports cars to be driven by American Phil Hill and Englishman Mike Spence of the BRM Grand Prix team. Also expected are entries from Ford, Ferrari, Porsche and Lola-Aston Martin teams.

The BOAC International 500 Trophy race ranks with the Le Mans 24-hours, the Targa Florio, the Nurburgring 1000-kilometres, the Daytona 24-hours and the Sebring 12-hours races as one of the major long-distance endurance events in the world. A cash award of £1000 awaits the winner, while BOAC—pioneers of world jet-liner services—are to award £1000 to the first gas-turbine-engined car to finish.

Saloon Car racing is becoming more and more popular, and today, with Redex Gold Cross Championship points at stake, all the favourites are entered. In the 1000 c.c. race Bernard Unett leads the Hillman Imp brigade with his Alan Fraser team car, but Peter Gaydon, Bill McGovern and Tony Taylor in their Imps won't be giving Unett any peace. The Mini-Cooper Ss of David Morgan—at the time of writing the leader of the Redex Championship—Charles Carling and Tony Morris will be well in the hunt, too.

In the over 1000 c.c. race the biggerengined Minis (1300 c.c.) fight the
Ford Anglias. Brian Cox, Colin Youle,
Ian Mitchell, John Wales, David Alexander, Mac Ross, Guy Edwards, Ken
Costello, David Morgan and Paul Bayley
are all expert at Mini racing—they are
so good it is impossible to predict a
winner! At recent Brands meetings the
duels between the evenly matched pair
Costello and Youle have been highlights
of the day's racing—perhaps they will
scrap again today?
