

#### CHAMPIONSHIPS ALL THE WAY

#### by Graham Macbeth

It is an all-championship day at Brands Hatch today and the British Racing & Sports Car Club has attracted the sort of varied entry list which can now be expected of the top level of Club racing. In the Redex Saloon Championship there are cars such as Roger Taylor's Escort Twin-Cam, the big-engined Anglias of Terry Croker, Richard Scantlebury, Chris Marshall, John Myerscough & Tony Roberts and the big, hairy Fords of Martin Birrane (an American built Fairlane) and Piers Townsend's (a Cortina, with a 4½-litre Daimler V8 unit under the bonnet). Townsend's Cortina, which he calls a "Damfraud" (mixing the names of Daimler with the "Fraud Cortina" description once used for Doc Merfield's V8-engined Cortina) has the distinction of being one of the only two non-Ford-engined cars in the Redex Gold Cross Championship race, the other being the Mini-Cooper to be driven by either Ron or Bob Mason, which has crept into the event by sporting an engine of 1301 cc capacity for this over-1300 cc event!

#### Schenken's Return

Formula Ford is on the way up and, for the second Brands Hatch car meeting in succession, there are so many entries for the Guards Championship race that it has to be split into two heats to find the fastest 20 qualifiers for the final. The last Guards Championship race was the first of the series in which "Mr. Formula Ford" - Australian driver Tim Schenken -- was not present. He was away taking third place in the international Formula 3 event at Mallory Park but he is due back with his Merlyn today to keep the boys in order. In his absence, Brian Smith (Bardahl Brabham) won from Renato Bertorelli's Merlyn with Tony Trimmer (Brabham) third and Mark Litchfield (Lotus) fourth and they will all be trying hard to prove that it was not just Schenken's absence which made them look quick. Ray Allen (Lotus), Claude Bourgoignie and Daniel Vanderborght (both in Russell Alexis cars) are other quick drivers to watch in Formula Ford, Bourgoignie still being the only driver to beat Schenken in this class of racing so far this season.


One of the most rapidly improving Formula 3 drivers of the present time is Bev Bond (who drives the Jean Allen Racing Brabham). He was in tremendous form at the recent Mallory Park international F3 race, two weeks ago, always being in the thickest part of the spectacular fights which were a feature of that event and he can be expected to return to Brands Hatch with new confidence in the knowledge that none of his competitors in today's Lombank Championship race was up with him in the Mallory Park final, even though the names concerned include Tony Lanfranchi, Tetsu Ikuzawa, "Sid" Williams, Mike Beuttler and Simon Saye. A nonstarter at Mallory Park was Jack Paterson, whose debut in the new Palliser Formula 3 car is awaited with interest at Brands Hatch.


New "prod" sports car record? In the Amasco Championship race for cars over 2000 cc, Rob Schroeder will be having yet another crack at the production sports car lap record which he broke two weeks ago in the usual E-type Jaguar battle with both Warren Pearce's and John Quick's cars against him on this occasion. Amasco championship leader John Gott's Austin Healey 3000 is up against some other quick ones of the same type driven by Sid Segal and Bill Viney as well as the very fleet Morgan Plus 4s of John and Bruce Stapleton.

John Britten's Midget is likely to narrow the gap for the lead in the class championship placings compared with Roger Enever's Midget and Rod Longton's TVR in the 1151-2000 cc category while, in the up-to-1150 cc section, the first seven place holders of the Amasco points table are all in the entry list—"Spridget" drivers Gabriel Konig Garo Nigogosian, Barry Wood, Alan Woode, John Elvers and Bob Evans and the Spitfire of Richard Lloyd.

The Tootal Menswear GT Champion-ship race gives good scope for those who like to forecast outright winners. It could come from any one of three classes—Barry Wood's Ford GT 40 in the over 2500 cc category, Roger Nathan's Nathan BMW in the 1601 - 2500 cc section or, from 1151 - 1600 cc list, Jim Morley's very quick Lotus 47 Europa or Alan Fowler's Lotus 23-based Mercury GT.









To watch Roger Nathan go screaming through Paddock Bend this afternoon in his Nathan BMW GT (currently holding the class lap record here) you would scarcely guess that, when he first raced here seven years ago, he spun at the same bend because he knew no better than to be using his overdrive! The car was a road-going Austin-Healey complete with badges all over the front and he was learning about racing the hard way, having just got his road license.

Now aged 24, he can be regarded as one of the most seasoned of drivers with many lap records to his credit all over the country and he can also be classed as a successful manufacturer of racing GT cars, 17 having been sold.

He used a Lotus Elite in 1962 but, not surprisingly, got precisely nowhere with this standard model using a single carburettor and, although a change to Stage 3 tune gave him the odd place, it hard going - Messrs. Graham Warner and Les Leston were better known Elite drivers in those days.

Now learning quickly, he built a proper racing Elite for 1963 and was usually in the first three, ending the season by winning the Autosport Champlenship. The same championship was his ambition for 1964 when he bought one of the brand new Brabham BT8 sports racing cars with 2-litre Climax engine. Several outright race wins came his way but he seemed to have trouble in most of the events which he really wanted to win. However, in the Autosport Championship final he only needed to finish in the first five to get the championship but the car let him down even then.

Really ambitious for 1965, he put an Oldsmobile 42-litre V8 unit in the BT8 and he had a car with enormius potentlal but it was a disastrous season with an almost complete lack of reliability. It was this season that he started tuning Hillman Imps with considerable success.

For 1966 he launched out with a sports car designed by Frank Costin and powered by a Nathan Imp engine. First time out it made overall fastest practice lap despite using a 1-litre engine and by the end of the season he had flattened even the works Abarths to score a 1150 cc class win at Montlhery. It being obvious that 1967 would be useless for sports car racing, the Nathan two-seater was rebuilt as a GT car and has since been almost unbeatable in the 1150 cc class. Using the Hillman engine in 1litre form, it laps in just about the same time as did the BT8 2-litre in 1964.

#### Amasco Production Sports Car Championship
