

SPECIAL AWARD.

TEST 1

Cars to start at Line AA (front wheels on line). Forward to all wheels over Line BB. Reverse to all wheels over Line CC. (PYLONS CC ARE PRE-SET TO WIDTH OF CAR PLUS 9".) Forward to all wheels over Line DD—Finish.




PENALTIES

- 5 marks for touching any pylon.
- 10 marks for not having all wheels over Lines BB, CC, DD.
- 20 marks for fouling Line FF with any wheel.

MARKING.—Competitors will be credited with 100 marks for each test from which their time, in seconds (part of a second to count as a full second) and penalties will be deducted.

TEST 2

Start with front wheels on Line A—engine running. Proceed from A to B as quickly as possible, stopping with rear wheels between first pair of Line B. Restart and proceed as quickly as possible to Line C, stopping ASTRIDE Line C.



PENALTIES

At intermediate stop (Line B) lose 10 marks if rear wheels are in Section 1, 20 marks in Section 2, 30 marks if in Section 3, 40 marks if in Section 4, if outside grid—lose all marks.

10 marks lost if not astride Line C.

MARKING.—Competitors will be credited with 100 marks for each test from which their time, in seconds (part of a second to count as a full second) and penalties will be deducted.

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

TEST 3

Car will start with front wheels on Line A, with engine switched off and driver standing immediately behind car. On command to start, drivers will run to car, start and proceed forward to stop ASTRIDE Line B, reverse, keeping Pylon C to the nearside, to finish ASTRIDE Line D with BOTH NEARSIDE wheels between Lines X and Y, which will be NINE inches apart.



MARKING.—Competitors will be credited with 100 marks for each test from which their time, in seconds (part of a second to count as a full second) and penalties will be deducted.

TEST 4

Start with car completely in any one of four Garages which you may choose. At the starting signal, enter completely each of the other three Garages in any order, either forward or in reverse, and return to the Garage in which you started, entering it in reverse with all four wheels over white line.

All parts of car MUST be within lines drawn between the four corner pylons.




PENALTIES

- 25 marks for not entering a garage completely.
- 25 marks on each occasion a pylon is touched. (If a pylon is moved, the car may NOT pass over the spot originally occupied by that pylon.)
- 40 marks for failing to enter final garage in reverse.

MARKING.—Competitors will be credited with 100 marks for each test from which their time, in seconds (part of a second to count as a full second) and penalties will be deducted.

Cars start on Line A. Drive alternately left and right of posts, circling last post and passing round pylons on opposite side to that taken originally. Circle post on Line A, and so repeat original course round posts until reaching Line B, which pass over for flying finish.




PENALTIES

- 30 marks for not completing test in sequence laid down.
- 5 marks per touch for touching any post.
- 30 marks per fault for not circling Posts A or B.

TEST 6

Start with front wheels on Line A, accelerate to B, stop astride line and switch off engine. Driver will alight, run round car, restart and accelerate to a flying finish over Line C. (Doors may be left open while car is stationary.)



PENALTIES

- 25 marks for failing to stop astride Line B.
- 20 marks for failing to stop engine.
- 10 marks per touch for each pylon.

Door or doors open whilst car is in motion—10 marks.

MARKING.—Competitors will be credited with 100 marks for each test from which their time, in seconds (part of a second to count as a full second) and penalties will be deducted.
