## GUARDS First in their class

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PORSCHE, FERRARI, LOLA, FORD, CHEVRON, LOTUS, DIVA AND ABARTH ENTRIES IN 102 MILE

The final line-up for the Guards Spring Cup sports car race at Oulton Park today reads like a "miniature LeMans". Porsche, Ferrari, Lola, Ford, Chevron, Lotus, Diva and Abarth cars are all listed. Supporting this 102 -mile race is the BRSCC Trophy Race for Formula 3 cars to be run in two 10-lap heats and a 25-lap (69 miles) final. Again the entry is superbreading like a "Who's Who?" in Formula 3 racing.

## FOUR FAVOURITES

Such is the quality of the entry that it is difficult to pinpoint someone who stands head and shoulders above the others in the list. Four must be picked out-David Piper's 4-litre Ferrari P4 prototype, the two 5-litre Lola-Chevrolet T70s of Mike de Udy and Sid Taylor (the latter has yet to nominate a driver for his car) and Australian sports car specialist Paul Hawkins with his Weslake-headed Ford GT40. Failing that, the Porsche contingent is strong. John Fitzpatrick and Swiss Rico

Steinemann are both down to pilot Porsche 910 prototypes, while Porsche Carrera 6 s will be diven by Tony Dean, Bill Bradley, John Morris and Roy Pike.

## FORD AND FERRARI

Piper and Hawkins apart, the traditional battle between Ford and Ferrari reaches Oulton Park once more. Peter Gethin in Tony Dean's splendid new 2-litre FerrariDino 206 stands a good chance, while Ferrari 250LM drivers Richard Bond and Chris Ashmore (a reserve) are also listed Joining Hawkins in Ford GT40s are David Prophet, George Humble and Peter Sadler (the latter two reserves).

## LOCAL CARS

Several of the Preston-built Chevron GTs have been entered, including the V8 BRM-engined car entered by Gordon Chubb Racing for Brian Redman. In BMW-powered Chevrons are Allan Rollinson and Chris Meek in the Teen Speed Martland, the last named in the works entry. John Bridges in the Chester Red Rose Motors Chevron has a potent Formula 2 Ford engine in his car.

TWO GOLD LEAF-TEAM LOTUS ENTRIES
Two Gold Leaf-Team Lotus Europas have been entered for John Miles and Jack Oliver, while John Hine, Trevor Taylor and Peter Gaydon will be driving similar machines. Doug Mockford and Alan Daykin have 1148 cc Diva GTs, while the smallest car in the race is Mike Walton's Italian Fiat-Abarth 1000SP.

## FANTASTIC FORMULA 3 FIELD

The Formula 3 entry is fantastic-one of the best ever assembled on a British track. In the first of the two 10-lap heats Ken Crook with his brand new Lotus 55 heads the list, which also includes Mike Walker in the Chequered Flag/Scalextric Racing Team McLaren Elva M4A, Charles Lucas and Chevron drivers Digby Martland an Ralph Allan Rollinson and local John Ralph, Allan Rocal Motors of Manchester entry Motors of Manchester entry.
Harry Stiller drives a Ken Bass Racing Merlyn Mk 10A, while among the Brabham pushers are Norman Foulds, David Powell, Peter Westbury, Dave Williamson
and Peter Fattorini. An Italian Tecno will be handled by Brian Newton.

## AND MORE . . .

And there are more top names in the second heat. John Miles drives the Gomm Metal Developments Lotus 55, while Morris Nunn has his older Lotus 41. American Roy Pike, winner of many Formula 3 races at Oulton, has a Titan, as have Peter Gaydon and Charles SawyerHoare, while saloon car exponent Chris Craft races an Italian Tecno. From Switzerland promising driver Jurg Dubler brings his semi-works de Sanctis, another Italian car, and he could well upset the established British stars. Egert Haglund is another foreign entry; he comes from Denmark with his Brabham.
Other fancied runners include Tony Lanfranchi (Merlyn Mk 10A), Dave Morgan (Lola T62), Ian Ashley (McLaren-Elva M4A), Dave Berry, Howard Heerey and Chris Williams (Chevrons) and Mike Keens, Ray Calcutt, Howden Ganley and Canadian Wayne Mitchell all in Brabhams. The final qualifies towards the 1968 Lombank Formula 3 Championship.

Alan Rollinson is one of the best known drivers at Oulton Park-yet he is only 24. Today he is racing a Formula 3 Chevron for the Chester-based Red Rose Motors team and a 2 -litre Chevron-BMW GT in the major Guards Spring Cup race for the newly-formed Techspeed Racing team.

Rollinson was the first pupil from Motor Racing Stables really to hit the headlines, Aged 18, he joined this successful racing drivers' school in 1962, bought a Formula Junior Cooper and raced it with reasonable success on a limited budget.

In 1964, Frank Lythgoe, a farmer from Lymm, Cheshire, approached Alan and offered him a drive in first a Lotus 27 and then a Lotus 22 fitted with a twincam Ford engine.

For 1965, Lythgoe purchased an exNormand Formula 2 Cooper-Cosworth T71, followed by a pair of F2 Brabham Cosworth BT16s. In club racing Alan had a lot of success with these cars, winning the Scottish Championship and being placed equal first in the Bob Gerard Championship.

Rollinson's 1966 season started late owing to an eye injury and Alan did not start racing until August. However, when he did he was very successful with the team's F3 Brabham BT18 and a Formule Libre Brabham BT16 fitted with a 1.6 -litre "stretched" Cosworth SCA motor

After doing well in the Argentine Temporada F3 series early in 1967 and winning race after race with Lythgoe's Brab ham BT21 (including eight on the trot) Alan decided to quit the hurly-burly of Formula 3 and concentrate on Formula 2 with "Farmer Frank's" new McLarenElva M4A

However, once again Alan had a shor season; on his very last Formula 3 drive the Brabham caught fire and Rollinson found himself in hospital with burns to his feet, face and a hand.

For 1968 Alan Rollinson has the two Chevron drives and he looks like getting other rides as well-perhaps even Formula 1. From Pelsall, Staffs., and recently married, he is the son of a builder-cumproperty owner and when not racing finds time to run a small racing car preparation business with Morris Nunn.
