The length of the timed section is  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile, on perimeter, good surface, 15ft. wide, gradient approx. 1 in 12. Electrically timed (Baume Longines Timing System).

A word as to the method of starting may be of interest to those who are unable actually to compete. Starting is carried out by means of a "hockey stick" placed in front of the car wheel which operates when the car moves forward. At the finish an "electric eye" is able to time to an accuracy of one hundredth of a second.



# A personal message from our Dice President






